

**Amberley Village Council  
Health, Education & Welfare Committee – Meeting Minutes  
July 31, 2009**

The Amberley Village Health, Education and Welfare Committee met at Village Hall on July 31, 2009 at 9:00 am.

In attendance were Leslie McIntosh, Peg Conway, Louis Katz, Fran Cohen, Bernie Boraten, and Anna Shaw.

The final draft of Amberley's waste removal specifications was accepted. Minor changes to section #14 will be made. Bernie Boraten will determine the dates for the posting and the bid opening.

The committee discussed involvement in the International Walk To School Day event scheduled for October 7, 2009. Leslie McIntosh has met with Cincinnati Public Schools and will continue to investigate the feasibility of this event for Amberley families with Pleasant Ridge Montessori School and Nativity School. Peg Conway voiced concern about student safety and wants to be involved only if the schools take the lead in the promotion and sponsorship. Louis Katz suggested that Hebrew Day School may also want information about the event. Information about Walk To School Day will be made available at the Ice Cream Social on August 23<sup>rd</sup>.

The committee discussed involvement in the Ice Cream Social. HEW will provide safety and health information handouts at the event. Leslie McIntosh will be on hand at the table with the literature and to answer questions.

The next meeting will be scheduled after the date of the waste removal bid opening has been determined.
