

STORM WATER ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES

May 08, 2014

Attendees: Bill Doering, Jon Chaiken, Wes Brown, Tom Muething, Stanley Cohen, John Eisenmann, Scot Lahrmer, Wayne Signer and Nimet Jeruzalmi

Minutes from October 24, 2013 were approved. Motion by Jeruzalmi and seconded by Chaiken.

John Eisenmann gave update on the previously recommended Village Green dam replacement. Bids have been received and the lowest is from Ford Development for \$338,670 which was \$12,290 less than CDS estimates. Work will include lowering the dam to a level below ODNR jurisdiction and new piping. The Streets Committee will make recommendation to full council on acceptance of bid.

A review of 2014 prioritized potential storm water projects was then reviewed by the committee with comments from village staff. Highlights included: Annual fee to county \$18,000, Estimate on AVMD labor and materials for ongoing maintenance and repair \$50,000. Culvert lining projects to four locations (Winding Way-Section –Section at Farm Acres-Arborcrest) \$159,000. Reestablish swale 7202 Fair Oaks \$8,270. Storm pipe replacement on Verger \$19,200. Annual televising of village SW pipes \$30,000 for about ¼ of the village.

Projects in conjunction with 2014 road program (50% of curb, catch basin and pipe repair/replacement). Fontaine /Frontenac, Springvalley, Gardner and Fairhaven \$82,000.

Projects for future road program (Farmcrest \$133,000, Kincaid \$50,000 and Section (near French Park entrance) \$410,000.

Lastly a list of other lower priority projects in various locations.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
