ORDINANCE 2008-20

ORDINANCE AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it being necessary to amend appropriations so that sufficient monies will be available for obligations to be met,

WHEREAS, the Village has previously budgeted funds for expenditures for the fiscal year 2008, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the #100 General Fund 2008 Appropriations be increased by \$317,384.00 for the cost of professional services/litigation related to the Crest Hills settlement; storm debris management, clearance, and related overtime; fuel; building maintenance and repair; temporary administrative assistance; income tax refunds; maintenance of fire hydrants; replacement of utility poles and traffic signal equipment; rain garden expenses; and street/corporation signs.

SECTION 2: That the #260 Drug/DUI Enforcement Fund 2008 Appropriations be increased by \$3,000.00 for the purchase of weapons for the Police Department.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is for the orderly handling of municipality business.
