RESOLUTION NO. 2008-16

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SUBURBAN DEER
MANAGEMENT/REDUCTION MEASURE

WHEREAS, the Health, Education and Welfare committee has met and recommends this resolution to ensure a biologically sound ecosystem for the community to protect the health, safety and property of the Village and its residents and to coexist with the deer population, and

WHEREAS, the committee has considered options and it has determined a need to perform a responsible deer culling,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring,

SECTION 1: To institute a culling program, not to exceed \$10,000, that is an item in the 2008 budget.

SECTION 2: Chief Monahan is authorized to institute the program pursuant to the permits and authorization of the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to perform the same in a safe, responsible and humane manner.

SECTION 3: To resolve to adopt a formal long-term management plan at a later date.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
