ORDINANCE NO. 2009-03

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FEMA FUNDS TO AMBERLEY VILLAGE FOR THE EXPENSES RELATED TO EMERGENCY RESPONSE FOR THE 2008 WINDSTORM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated from the #280 Federal and State Grant Fund – FEMA the sum of \$106,609 to the #100 General Fund, for the purpose of reimbursement of expenses related to the emergency response to the 2008 windstorm in the Village.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is for the orderly handling of municipality business.
