ORDINANCE NO. 2009-22

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2009,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it being necessary to amend appropriations so that sufficient monies will be available for obligations to be met,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the additional sum of \$256,293.00 be appropriated in the #100 General Fund for the purpose of Village expenditures.

SECTION 2: That the additional sum of \$110,500.00 be appropriated to the #230 Police & Fire Pension Special Revenue Fund for the purpose of police and fire pension expenditures.

SECTION 3: That the additional sum of \$6,235,446.00 be appropriated in the #300 Bond Retirement Fund for the purpose of the Amberley Green bond and bond expenses.

SECTION 4: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is for the orderly handling of municipal business.
