ORDINANCE NO. 2010 – 15

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE C-817, RELATING TO EMPLOYEE
VACATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That Section 35.03, Subsections (A), (B), (C) and (D) of the Village Code of Ordinances, effective as of January 1, 2010, are hereby amended, and Subsections (E) and (F) be added, as follows:

- (A) All full-time Village employees, after 12 consecutive months and through five consecutive years of employment, shall be entitled, each year, to twelve working days vacation with pay, which shall be taken during the 12-month period commencing with the anniversary date of the employee's employment, and the time during which the vacation is taken shall be subject to approval by the Village Manager.
- (B) All full-time Village employees, after six and through ten consecutive years of employment, shall be entitled to fifteen working days vacation with pay. The vacation shall be taken during the 12-month period commencing with the anniversary date of the employee's employment, and the time during which the vacation is taken shall be subject to approval by the Village Manager.
- (C) All full-time Village employees, after eleven and through fourteen consecutive years of employment, shall be entitled to eighteen days of vacation with pay. The vacation shall be taken during the 12-month period commencing with the anniversary date of the employee's employment, and the time during which the vacation is taken shall be subject to approval by the Village Manager.
- (D) All full-time Village employees, after fifteen and through nineteen consecutive years of employment, shall be entitled to twenty-one days of vacation with pay. The vacation shall be taken during the 12-month period commencing with the anniversary date of the employee's employment, and the time during which the vacation is taken shall be subject to approval by the Village Manager.
- (E) All full-time Village employees, after twenty and through twenty-four consecutive years of employment, shall be entitled to twenty-five days of vacation with pay. The vacation shall be taken during the 12-month period commencing with the anniversary date of the employee's employment, and the time during which the vacation is taken shall be subject to approval by the Village Manager.

(F) All full-time Village employees, after twenty-five or more consecutive years of employment, shall be entitled to twenty-seven days of vacation with pay. The vacation shall be taken during the 12-month period commencing with the anniversary date of the employee's employment, and the time during which the vacation is taken shall be subject to approval by the Village Manager.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall go into effect forthwith.
