ORDINANCE 2011-04

ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2011,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it being to amend appropriations and transfer certain Village funds so that sufficient monies will be available for obligations to be met by other funds,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the sum of \$21,000.00 be transferred from the #100 General Fund, and appropriated to the #400 Capital Projects Fund, for the purpose of capital project expenditures.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is for the orderly handling of municipal business.
