RESOLUTION NO. 2012-55

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER  
TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO PURCHASE POLICE CRUISERS**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Police Department provides valuable services to the Village and its residents;

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department utilizes specially-equipped vehicles in order to provide law enforcement and safety services to the Village;

**WHEREAS**, from time to time the Village must purchase newer vehicles to replace those that have become outdated, inefficient, or unusable;

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department identified the need to purchase two used vehicles from the Village of Newtown at a purchase price of \$18,500 each, plus a cost of \$1,000 for each vehicle for vehicle changeovers, and \$1,000 each for vehicle markings;

**WHEREAS**, the purchase of the two used vehicles would coincide with removing from service three older police vehicles that have reached their end of service life, which is expected to result in a cost savings to the Village and is less than the amount budgeted for 2013 for such purchase;

**WHEREAS**, Council determines it is in the best interest of the Village to purchase the two used police vehicles;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE** Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1:** That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with the Village of Newtown for the purchase of two used police vehicles for a price not to exceed \$41,000 for both vehicles, including the cost of vehicle changeovers and markings.

**SECTION 2:** This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
