ORDINANCE NO. 2013-14

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING #801 UNCLAIMED MONIES AGENCY FUND

WHEREAS, for budgetary and accounting purposes, Council determines it is necessary to establish a specific fund with respect to unclaimed funds owed by the Village to persons who cannot be located;

WHEREAS, Council determines it is necessary to attempt to notify said person for a period of five years;

WHEREAS, Council determines it is necessary to maintain such funds segregated for a period of five years or until claimed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby established the following Village fund for the purpose of maintaining and managing unclaimed funds:

#801 Unclaimed Monies Agency Fund

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is the necessity of immediately establishing and maintaining proper and accurate financial records of the Village.
