RESOLUTION 2013 - 13

PROCLAIMING MAY 19-25, 2013, AS NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK

WHEREAS, public works services provided in our community are an integral part of our citizens' everyday lives; and

WHEREAS, the support of an understanding and informed citizenry is vital to the efficient operation of public works systems and programs such as sewers, streets and highways, public buildings and snow removal; and

WHEREAS, the health, safety and comfort of this community greatly depends on these facilities and services; and

WHEREAS, the quality and effectiveness of these facilities, as well as their planning, design and construction, are vitally dependent upon the efforts and skill of public works officials; and

WHEREAS, the efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff public works departments is materially influenced by the people's attitudes and understanding of the importance of the work they perform.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Amberley, Ohio, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Amberley, Ohio, hereby designates and proclaims May 19-25, 2013, as National Public Works Week in the Village of Amberley.

SECTION 2. That all citizens and civic organizations of the Village of Amberley are encouraged to recognize the contributions that public works officials make every day to their health, safety and comfort.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
