ORDINANCE NO. 2014-13

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014

WHEREAS, it being necessary to amend appropriations so that sufficient monies will be available for obligations to be met,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the sum of \$38,000.00 be appropriated in the #1000 General Fund; \$12,000 to be used for pedestrian safety needs, \$16,000 for road salt and \$10,000 for Fire Pay.

SECTION 2: That the sum of \$78,285 be appropriated in the #2902 Police Levy Fund for payment of Police payroll obligations.

SECTION 3: That the sum of \$96,000 be appropriated in the #9904 Kenwood Southwest JEDZ Agency Fund for disbursement of funds to Sycamore Township and to Amberley Village as required by the JEDZ agreement.

SECTION 4: That in accordance with Village Charter Article IX, Section 1, and Article X, Section 4, this ordinance may be passed upon a single reading and shall become effective forthwith on its adoption.
