ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 1

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31.10 OF THE VILLAGE CODE TO
ALLOW MEETINGS TO BE RESCHEDULED BY MOTION

WHEREAS, Village Charter, Article III, Section 4, requires the Village to hold at least 12 regular Council meetings each year, as set by ordinance;

WHEREAS, Village Code Section 31.10 sets the time and dates for Council meetings, which currently fall on the second Monday of each month;

WHEREAS, occasionally it is necessary to reschedule Council meetings to account for holidays or other conflicts;

WHEREAS, enabling Council to change the time or date of a regular Council meeting by motion, instead of by ordinance, would give Council greater flexibility and be a more efficient method of amending the meeting schedule;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: Section 31.10 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

§ 31.10 REGULAR MEETINGS.

One regular meeting of the Village Council shall be held each month in the Village Administration Building on the second Monday of that month at 6:30 p.m. [Village Council may change the time or date of any regular meeting for any reason by motion approved by a majority of Council.](#)

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is to enable Council to change the date of an upcoming meeting without delay to promote the efficient operation of the Village.
