RESOLUTION NO. 2015-1

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT WITH THE BALDWIN GROUP, INC. TO PURCHASE SOFTWARE
FOR MAYOR'S COURT

WHEREAS, the Amberley Village Mayor's Court is designed to efficiently process certain offenses, which requires the use of computer software to help manage the caseload and payments for fines and penalties;

WHEREAS, the Village Finance Committee met and reviewed the existing software and determined that it is outdated, not adequately supported by the vendor, and does not provide some of the services needed by the Mayor's Court;

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee recommends the purchase of a new software package from The Baldwin Group, Inc., at a cost of \$10,144 for the first year, which includes purchase of the software, installation, training, and a one-year license and technical support package, with subsequent annual support costs to be approximately \$1,600.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with The Baldwin Group, Inc., for the purchase of a new software and support package for the Village Mayor's Court, at a price not to exceed \$10,144 for the first calendar year.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
