RESOLUTION NO. 2015-4

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER
INTO A CONTRACT TO PURCHASE CAMERA EQUIPMENT
FOR TWO POLICE CRUISERS

WHEREAS, the Amberley Village Police Department provides valuable services to the Village and its residents;

WHEREAS, some police vehicles are equipped with on-board camera systems to better enable the Police Department to perform their duties and protect the public;

WHEREAS, the existing camera systems on two police vehicles are outdated and need to be upgraded;

WHEREAS, the Village received a proposal from WatchGuard Video to provide new camera systems for the two police cruisers at a cost not to exceed \$10,040;

WHEREAS, the Police and Fire Committee met to consider the proposal and recommends purchasing said equipment;

WHEREAS, Council determines it is in the best interest of the Village to purchase the necessary equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with WatchGuard Video for the purchase of camera systems to equip two police cruisers at a price not to exceed \$10,040.00.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
