ORDINANCE NO. 2016-4

ORDINANCE AMENDING VILLAGE CODE 36.02 PERTAINING TO POLICE  
DEPARTMENT JOB CLASSIFICATIONS

**WHEREAS**, Amberley Village greatly values the hard work and contributions by its police officers;

**WHEREAS**, from time to time as the needs and resources of the Police Department change, the organization and structure of the Department needs to be modified;

**WHEREAS**, the Detective recently retired, and his position will not be filled directly or by one person;

**WHEREAS**, Council determines, based on the recommendation from staff, that the job classifications for the Police Department should be modified so as to provide the greatest flexibility and efficiency for the Department;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE** Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, \_\_\_\_\_ members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1:** Section 36.02 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

**§ 36.02 POSITIONS AND CLASSIFICATIONS.**

The Police Department is authorized to employ up to 18 police officers of various positions and classifications. Positions and classifications within the Department shall be established by the Village Manager after consultation with the Chief of Police. The Department may employ dispatchers, clerks, or other administrative personnel as needed. Compensation for all Police Department employees shall be established by Council.

**SECTION 2:** The salary for the position of Detective shall be the same as the salary for Police Officers who have had at least two years of service with the Village. This change is retroactive to January 10, 2016.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall become effective on the first day allowed by law.
