RESOLUTION NO. 2016-17

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO
CONTRACT WITH MUNICIPAL & CONTRACTOR SEALING PRODUCTS TO
PERFORM STORM WATER WORK ON LAMARQUE DRIVE

WHEREAS, the Village maintains a storm water system to manage and control storm water runoff and protect public and private property from water damage;

WHEREAS, a section of a 42-inch storm water pipe located on property located at 3305 Lamarque Drive has developed cracks and separated joints in need of repair;

WHEREAS, Staff and the Village Engineer met and reviewed the project with local contractors and have proposed certain repairs to the damaged pipe;

WHEREAS, the project was put out to bid and Municipal & Contractor Sealing Products (MCSP) was the lowest bidder at \$43,750;

WHEREAS, the Streets, Public Utilities and Sewers Committee reviewed the proposals and recommends awarding the contract to MCSP as the lowest and best bidder;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: Council finds and determines that the proposal from Municipal & Contractor Sealing Products is the lowest and best bid, and hereby directs and authorizes the Village Manager to enter into a contract with MCSP to repair the storm water pipe located at 3305 Lamarque Drive at a price not to exceed \$43,750. Any change orders or alterations to the project estimated at an aggregate of \$7,500 or less over the contract price may be approved by the Manager administratively.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
