RESOLUTION NO. 2016-19

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT FOR POLICE CRUISERS

WHEREAS, Council recently approved the purchase of two new police cruisers to help the Police Department provide valuable services to the Village and its residents;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to purchase specialized equipment to outfit the vehicles in order to provide police and public safety services;

WHEREAS, the Village obtained a proposal from Camp Safety Equipment to provide specialized equipment and install it on the new vehicles, as well as remove certain equipment from the old vehicles and install it in the new vehicles, for a total cost of \$17,864.35;

WHEREAS, the Village obtained a proposal from SignTech to provide new striping and decals for the vehicles at a cost of \$1,167.00 per car, for a total cost of \$2,334.00;

WHEREAS, the total cost of all purchases for the two vehicles would be \$20,198.35;

WHEREAS, the Police/Fire Committee reviewed this proposal and recommends approval by Council;

WHEREAS, Council determines it is in the best interest of the Village to purchase the necessary equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with Camp Safety Equipment based on its proposal for the purchase of equipment necessary for two new police cruisers at a cost not to exceed \$17,864.35. The manager is further authorized and directed to purchase striping, decals, and related signage from SignTech for a total cost not to exceed \$2,334.00.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
