ORDINANCE NO. 2019-5

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE 2019-1 FIXING COMPENSATION
FOR VILLAGE EMPLOYEES THAT WAS PASSED ON MARCH 11, 2019 AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2019-1 Fixing Compensation for Village Employees was passed on March 11, 2019;

WHEREAS, due to an oversight it was assigned Ordinance No. 2019-1, which number had been previously used on an Ordinance that was passed on January 14, 2019;

WHEREAS, in order to correct the numbering oversight, Council desires to amend the above-referenced Ordinance 2019-1 that was passed on March 11, 2019 in number only;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10.04(B)(1) of the Amberley Village Code, the amendment of this Ordinance does not affect the prior operation of the Ordinance or any prior action taken thereunder;

WHEREAS, the provisions of the previous Ordinance 2019-1 passed on March 11, 2019 remain in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring.

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 2019-1 Fixing Compensation for Village Employees that was passed on March 11, 2019, is hereby renumbered with the new Ordinance number 2019-5.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is the necessity of amending the above-referenced Ordinance in order to correct the Ordinance number to avoid confusion and to provide accurate information and full disclosure to the citizens of Amberley Village as soon as possible.
