RESOLUTION SUPPORTING OHIO HOUSE BILL 62 AND GOVERNOR  
DEWINE'S GAS TAX PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, proper maintenance of Ohio's infrastructure including its roads is critical to the economic future and safety of the citizens of the state; and

WHEREAS, it has been nine years since the last increase in gas tax in the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, local communities are being forced to use more of its General Fund resources to help maintain the roads in its communities and this has meant reductions in critical services like public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That we strongly support the proposed increase in the Ohio Motor Fuel Tax.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


