RESOLUTION NO. 2019-21

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ELLIS PAINTING FOR THE PAINTING OF FIRE HYDRANTS

WHEREAS, the Village has a number of fire hydrants which require periodic painting;

WHEREAS, Council has made it a priority to reduce Village expenses and increase efficiencies wherever possible in order to provide essential services to Village residents for the lowest possible cost;

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its citizens that the fire hydrants be painted to improve visibility;

WHEREAS, the Streets, Public Utilities and Sewers Committee has reviewed the matter and is recommending that the Village enter into a contract with Ellis Painting for the painting of 275 fire hydrants at a cost of \$37.00 per hydrant for a total contract amount of \$10,175.00;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring,

SECTION 1: The Village Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with Ellis Painting for the painting of fire hydrants.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
