RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT TO PURCHASE A NEW DELL POWER SERVER EDGE FOR
VILLAGE OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the Village currently has one computer server which is running out of storage space and has exceeded its warranty;

WHEREAS, the Village information technology company that manages the Village server advises that the typical server replacement normally occurs between 5 and 7 years and the current server was purchased in 2012 at a cost of \$21,112.00;

WHEREAS, the Village information technology company recommends replacement of the server at a cost of \$27,517.00 which will be purchased from Intrust IT;

WHEREAS, the Police and Fire Committee recommends the purchase of the replacement server;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, six (6) members elected thereto concurring,

SECTION 1: That the Village Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Intrust IT for the purchase of a new server.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
