RE: Reimbursement to Greater Cincinnati Water Works (GCWW) for pavement restoration

ITEM: Reimbursement for pavement restoration associated with the GCWW Water Main Replacement Project in the Brookwood Subdivision.

Action Requested: By motion, adopt **Resolution 2013-14** authorizing the Village Manager to reimburse the GCWW for paving as agreed to by Council in May of 2011.

PURPOSE: To reimburse GCWW for pavement restoration outside the limits of the water main replacement project thereby maintaining the Village streets in a uniform condition.

Greater Cincinnati Water Works recently completed a project in the Village to replace some of the aging water main infrastructure in the Brookwood Subdivision. The streets impacted were certain parts of Willowbrook Drive and Lane, Oakridge Drive, Meadowbrook Drive and Fair Oaks Drive (north of Section Road). Following the completion of the water main work, the Village and GCWW agreed to partner to repave the roadway surfaces impacted by the water main replacement project. The agreement was for the Village to fund the portion of the paving outside the limits of the lane impacted by GCWW's construction activity. By partnering with GCWW, Amberley would get four of our streets repaved for approximately 50% of the actual costs. Additionally, the roadways will be maintained in a consistent manner, meaning, both halves of the street pavement will be renewed, not half new and half thirteen years old. Funds were appropriated by Council and encumbered to cover this expense in May of 2011 but no enabling legislation was approved authorizing the reimbursement to GCWW.

This paving work was held off from last fall due to weather conditions and was completed two weeks ago. The agreement to reimburse GCWW for the paving totals \$47,971.48.

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-14

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO
REIMBURSE GREATER CINCINNATI WATER WORKS FOR
PAVING WORK IN BROOKWOOD SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, In May 2011, Amberley Village Council authorized Greater Cincinnati Water Works (GCWW) to perform work pertaining to the Water Main Replacement Project in the Brookwood Subdivision in Amberley Village;

WHEREAS, Council subsequently authorized GCWW to perform restorative paving work on streets affected by the water main replacement;

WHEREAS, due to the construction schedule of the water main replacement and weather concerns, the paving work is scheduled to occur in Spring/Summer 2013;

WHEREAS, Council previously appropriated and encumbered funding for the cost thereof, but legislation was not adopted to explicitly authorize payment to GCWW;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, _____ (__) members elected thereto concurring,

SECTION 1: The Village Manager is authorized to pay Greater Cincinnati Water Works up to \$47,971.48 for restorative paving work in connection with the Water Main Replacement Project in the Brookwood Subdivision, and to take all necessary and reasonable steps to implement the work.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
