RE: Adopting the Village Code Update

ITEM: To adopt the re-codification of the Village code of ordinances.

ACTION REQUESTED: By motion, adopt **Ordinance 2014-02** adopting and enacting a supplement to the code of ordinances.

PURPOSE: To adopt the updated local and state legislation into the existing code which will provide a current and accurate version of the Village's ordinances.

The update or re-codification of the Village code has been completed by American Legal Publishing. This update incorporates legislation adopted since the last code update through June 10, 2013 and provides for statutory changes to the Ohio Revised Code. The process took approximately 90 days, which is typical, and included a redline review by the Village Solicitor, Kevin Frank. The code update was budgeted for a total of \$7,550 and came in \$1,358.10 lower in cost. The Village has received the final updated version of the code and has linked the digital version to the Village website. The final step in this process is for council to adopt and enact the updated version of the code in its entirety.

Council members may access a copy of the new code update by clicking on the **Village Code** link on the front page of the Village website.

Ordinance 2014-02 authorizes the adoption of the re-codification of the village code.

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-02

ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio has completed the S-8 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the Village, said Supplement containing all ordinances of a general nature enacted since the most recent supplement through June 10, 2013, and,

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation has recommended the revision to or addition of certain sections for inclusion within the Village Code that are identical to or based upon a section of the Ohio Revised Code, and has included within the S-8 Supplement such revisions or additions, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of Council to adopt these revisions and additions so that the Village Code will be in conformity with changes and amendments to the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, OHIO, _____ (__) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the 2013 S-8 Supplement to the Village Code of Ordinances as printed and published by American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio, be, and the same hereby is, adopted and enacted, and incorporated by reference as if set out in its entirety herein, and it shall be retained at the Village Municipal Building, available to the general public.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is the necessity of bringing current at the earliest possible time the Village Code of Ordinances.
