**RE:** Adjustment to 2015 Appropriations

**ITEM:** An adjustment to 2015 appropriations.

**ACTION REQUESTED:** By motion, adopt **Ordinance 2015-18** amending the 2015 appropriations for the Employee Health Insurance Agency Fund (9902).

**PURPOSE:** To appropriate funds in the Employee Health Insurance Agency Fund.

Since August 2011, employees have been required to pay a percentage of their health insurance premiums. Currently employees contribute 15% of the cost of premiums if they select the Platinum B insurance coverage (our base plan) and 15% of the base plan plus the entire additional cost if they choose to "buy up" to the Platinum A program. With open enrollment in August, several employees have made the choice to "buy up". As a result of this, as well as the addition of three new employees on the plan, the employee contribution is more than anticipated when the budget was drafted. It is necessary to increase appropriations by \$10,000 in this fund in order to disburse the employee portion of the health care premiums for the year.

This fund is basically a holding place for the money deducted from the employees' pay checks until the premiums are paid. Normally, the money goes in and comes out during the same month, carrying a zero balance.

The purpose of this ordinance is to appropriate sufficient funds to cover premium payments for the rest of the year.

The Finance Committee is recommending adoption of this ordinance. If you have any questions, please let me know.
