RESOLUTION NO. 2021-14

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BRINE SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Village strives to maintain its roadways in the best possible conditions during inclement weather to ensure the safety of residents and visitors,

WHEREAS, the Village has been using its original Accubrine brine maker since the purchase of the machine in the summer of 2011 for the Village's snow and ice fighting needs. However, the salinity meter and other components on the brine maker are failing and unable to be repaired/replaced,

WHEREAS, staff has done extensive research and identified the Cargill Accubrine system as the most suitable replacement due to reimbursements offered by Cargill and the compatibility with current components. The cost of the Cargill Accubrine brine maker is \$53,282

WHEREAS, a new brine maker was budgeted in the 2021 Budget for \$35,000, however, the remaining \$18,282 will need to be appropriated or absorbed within the budget.

WHEREAS, the Streets, Public Utilities and Sewers Committee met on April 27, considered the proposal and recommended its purchase at a cost of \$53,282.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed by the Village to enter into all necessary contracts for the trade-in of the Village's existing brine making system and for the purchase of a new Cargill Accubrine system in the amount of \$53,282.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
